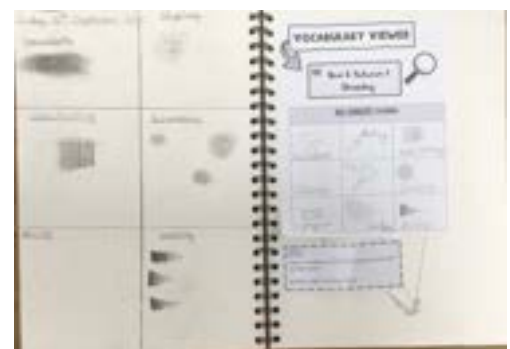
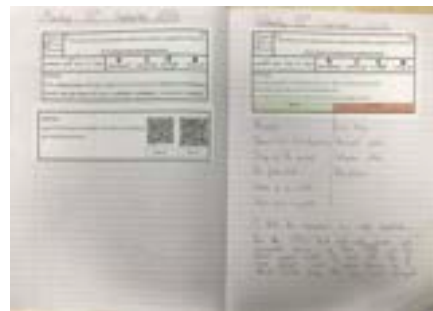
Subject focus:
