Super Cricketer! Attends training with Yorkshire UIOs, which is 1 year above his age.

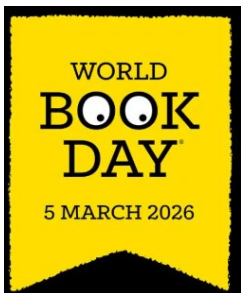
